**GENERAL MEDICAL INFORMATION**

**EMERGENCIES: Dial 9-1-1.** This universal emergency number can be dialed from any working phone including payphones without requiring prior payment and will connect you with an operator who can dispatch emergency services such as ambulance, police, or fire Dept.

**NON-EMERGENCY: Dial 8-1-1.** For free-of-charge health information and advice phone line available in British Columbia. The 8-1-1 phone line is operated by HealthLink BC, which is part of the Ministry of Health. By calling 8-1-1, you can speak to a health services representative, who can help you find health information and services; or connect you directly with a registered nurse, a registered dietitian or a pharmacist.

**MEDICAL FACILITIES AND HEALTH INFORMATION:** The level of public health and sanitation in Canada is high. Canada's medical care is of a high standard but is government-controlled. Quick and easy access to ongoing medical care is difficult for temporary visitors who are not members of each province's government-run health care plans. Many physicians will not take new patients. Access to a specialist is only by referral and may take months to obtain. Emergency room waits can be very long.

Traveler's medical insurance is highly recommended even for brief visits. No Canadian health care provider accepts U.S. domestic health insurance, and Medicare coverage does not extend outside the

United States. Visitors who seek any medical attention in Canada should be prepared to pay cash in full at the time the service is rendered.
